Description

Rabbit polyclonal antibody against non-denatured CopGFP.

Immunogen

Full-length recombinant non-denatured CopGFP comprising 6XHis tag.

Specificity

The antibody has been selected to recognize non-denatured CopGFP.

Heat- or chemically denatured protein lacks antigen determinants.

The antibody shows little or no cross-reactivity with other fluorescent proteins like EGFP, TurboGFP, KFP-Red, and DsRed2.

Antibody preparation

Full-length recombinant CopGFP comprising 6XHis tag was purified from transformed *E. coli* using metal-ion affinity chromatography. Antibody was produced in rabbits immunized with the recombinant non-denatured CopGFP. Specific IgG were purified by CopGFP affinity chromatography.

Formulation

Lyophilized from the buffer containing 0.1% mannitol, 0.1% dextran, 0.1M NaCl, 0.01M Na₂PO₄, and 0.01M NaBO₃; pH 7.4.

Reconstitution

Reconstitute with sterile water or 50% glycerol.

Storage

Lyophilized samples are stable for twelve months from date of receipt when stored at -20°C. The presence of silica gel drier is advisable.

Reconstituted with sterile water, antibody can be stored at +2 — +8°C for three months without detectable loss of activity.

Reconstituted with 50% glycerol, antibody can be stored at -20°C in a manual defrost freezer for six months without detectable loss of activity. Aliquot antibody upon reconstitution. Avoid repeated freeze / thaw cycles.
